


23. The Lord's Supper

Look It Up:
Luke 22:14-23

Judas agreed to betray Jesus to the religious leaders for money. In the meantime, there was a special celebration called the Passover.

Jesus wanted to celebrate this with his disciples, so he told them to get a room ready. When they were at the table, Jesus thanked God for the meal. He broke some bread and gave it to the disciples. Then he took some wine and gave it to them. In

the future, when the disciples ate bread and wine in this way, they remembered Jesus. But then something strange happened. Jesus said, 'The hand of the one who will betray me is with mine on the table. It is the one to whom I will give this piece of bread.' Jesus gave it to Judas. Judas immediately left the room.

John 6:35 - Jesus said to them, 'I am the _____ of _____; whoever comes to me shall not _____, and whoever _____ in me will never _____.'


24. Remember! Remember!

Jesus told his followers to eat the bread and drink the wine in order to remember him. Here is something you can make to remind you of God's goodness.

You will need:

Egg shells, egg box, cotton wool, pens, cress seeds.

It can take between 2 and 5 days for your cress seeds to grow.



Instructions:

1. Wash out some egg shells and sit them in the egg box.
2. Draw on some funny faces, use googly eyes if you have any.
3. Put cotton wool inside the shells and dampen this with some water.
4. Sprinkle cress seeds all over the cotton wool.
5. Put on a windowsill and wait for hair to sprout.
6. Add a little water to the cotton wool now and again.
7. Remember to write some words about God on the egg box.
8. Use the cress on your sandwiches when it is ready.
