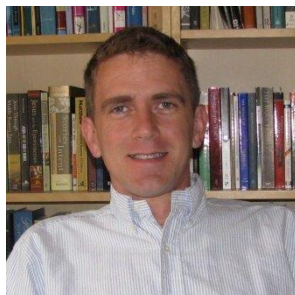
Which god is God?

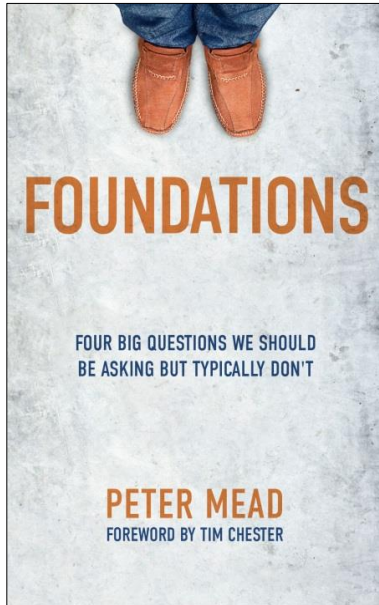
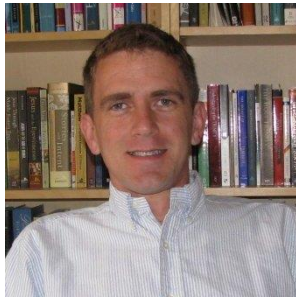

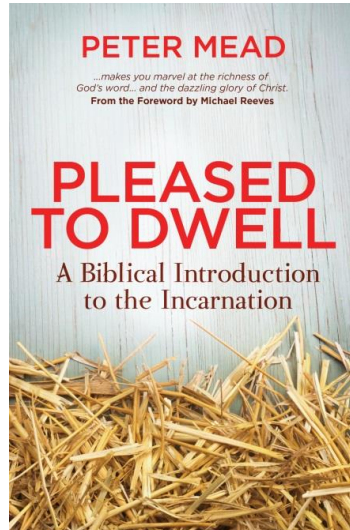
