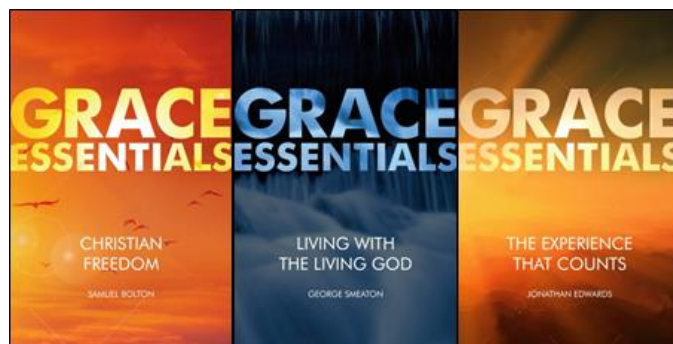
Christian Focus Publications partners with Grace Publications Trust for the new Grace Essentials Collection

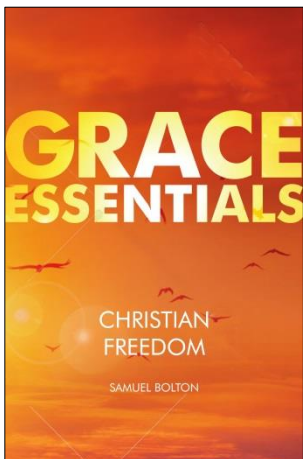

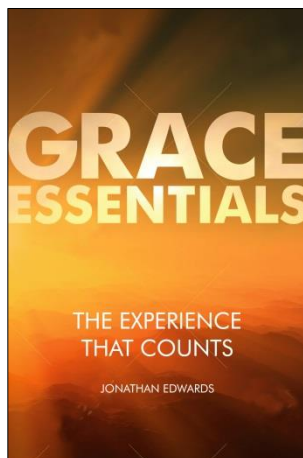

Christian Freedom provides an accessible entry into Samuel Bolton's original work, *The True Bounds of Christian Freedom*, first published in 1645. Bolton shows us clearly that real Christian obedience comes from a changed heart, and is motivated by love for God. 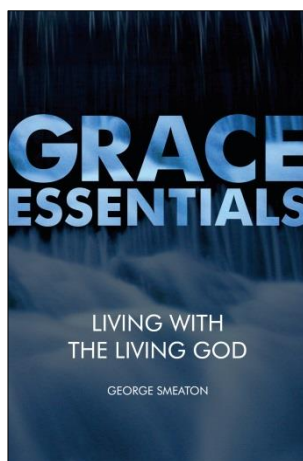
