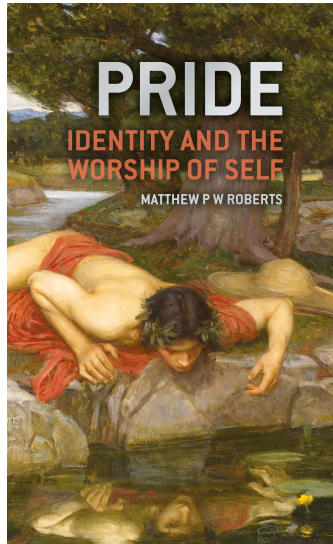

**DESCRIPTION**
