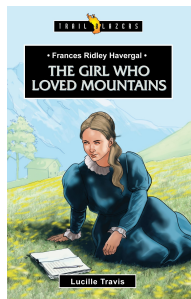
ENDORSEMENTS

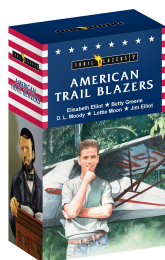
