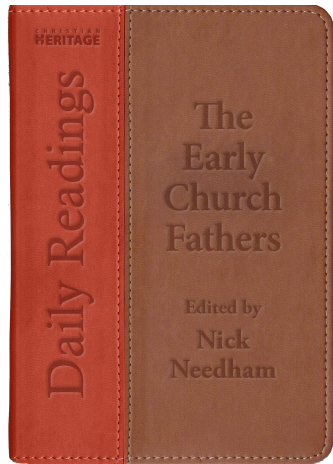


Daily Readings - the Early Church Fathers

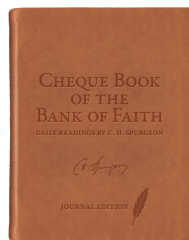

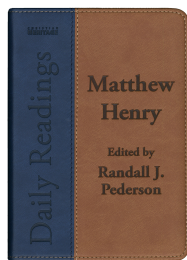

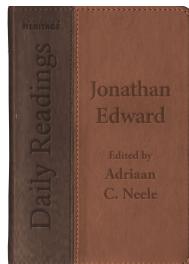
