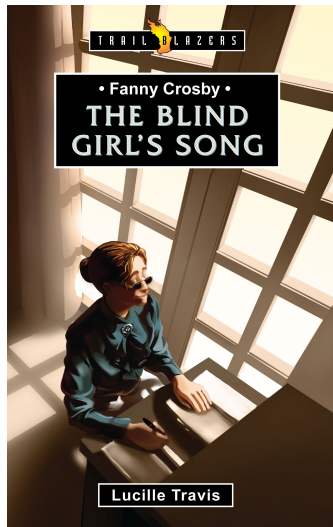


Fanny Crosby: The Blind Girl's Song

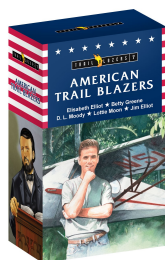
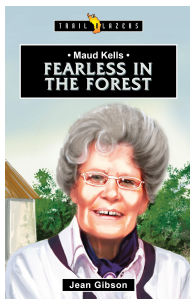
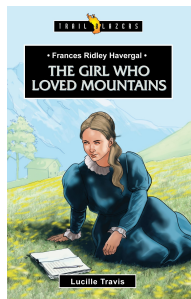
