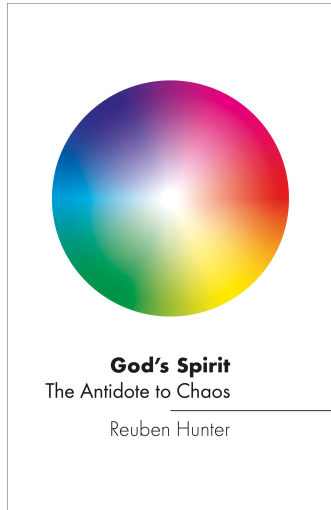


God's Spirit
