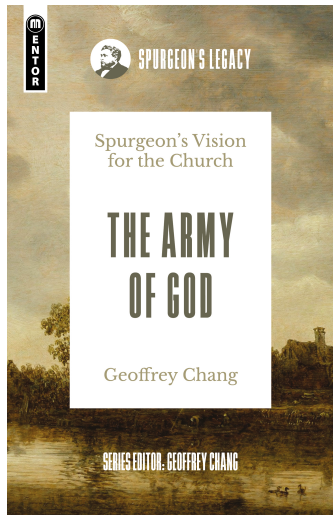

DESCRIPTION

Charles Haddon Spurgeon faithfully served the Metropolitan Tabernacle from 1854 to his death in 1892. Undergirding everything else was this central responsibility: Spurgeon was the pastor of a church. What was Spurgeon's ecclesiology and how did it affect how he ordered and led his local church? 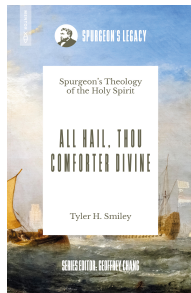

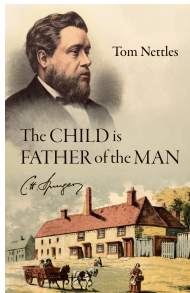

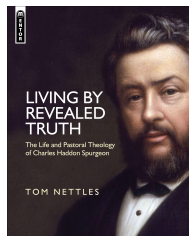
